Mat-Su Central School Academic Advisory Council (AAC) Voting

AAC Elections are open December 18th, 19th, and 20th.

The **Academic Advisory Council (AAC)** at Mat-Su Central has three seats up for re-election. The three candidates with the most votes will be seated in January. Successful candidates will be announced at the regular AAC meeting in January 2019. Candidate information is available on the Mat-Su Central website: www.matsucentral.org Each family can vote one ballot.

Who can vote: Parents, legal guardians, MSC staff, emancipated students or adult advocates of students enrolled in Mat-Su Central School on the day of the election are eligible to vote in elections. Each family and staff member shall have one vote.

How to Vote: Families: choose up to three of the candidates listed on the ballot below, using an X, checkmark, circling the candidate’s name, or by filling in the box. **Ballots may either be forwarded by email to Jennifer.Bogle@matsuk12.us or printed and turned in to Jennifer Bogle, Mat-Su Central Registrar, directly in her office at Mat-Su Central School.**

Voting is open 8:00am on Tuesday, December 18, 2018 through Thursday, December 20, 2018 at 3:30 pm. Results will be announced at the AAC meeting on Monday, January 14, 2019 and in the next MCS Newsletter. Any ballot not received in the Registrar’s office between 8:00 am on December 18th and 3:30 PM on December 20th, 2018 will not be counted.
