# Reading at Emmbrook Junior School.

## **Guided Reading**

This is carried out in school every day and children are ability grouped and work through activities set by their class teacher. This is when the class teacher will hear your child read and teach reading skills. Texts are selected that challenge children with their teacher's support.

## **Home Reading**

Books are sent home for your child to read with you to practise the skills taught at school. This is sometimes called reading "mileage."

# The Current Scheme

## **The Emmbrook Scheme**

Children will already have

- Book from our coloured graded books  
or
- An independent reading book  
or
- General fiction reading book

These books can be changed by the children when they are finished, every day if necessary. The children select their own books within the band they are on and parents can provide feedback in the reading diary. Class teachers hear children read these books once every half term to assess if it is at the correct level. Children choose these books themselves and this encourages children to look for books that interest them.

**The children can also borrow non fiction and picture books.**

# The New Key Stage 2 Oxford Reading Tree Books.

- Books are graded and a starting point for each child is selected by an adult
- Books are only changed if they have been read to or discussed with an adult and it has been recorded in the **new reading diary**
- Books will be changed on selected days by an adult when completed
- Books cater for all Key Stage 2 children and include abridged classics
- Books cater for the interests of all children
- There is a good range of fiction and non fiction
