Appointment of Professor for Sir M Visvesvaraya – ISRO Chair

Bangalore University in collaboration with Indian Space Research Organization, Bengaluru is continuing a prestigious Sir M Visvesvaraya – ISRO Chair in the Department of Physics, Jnanabharathi campus, Bengaluru. The University is seeking outstanding scientist/engineer/academicians in the field of space science, space technology, space applications, atmospheric science and/or related fields. Bangalore University invites applications for Chair professor and applicant should have an experience of interaction with the Indian Space Programme and must have proven record in terms of publications in carrying out advanced research in the area of space science. The selected candidate should be capable of directing multidisciplinary studies in space science, space technology and space applications.

The Chair professor shall be responsible for guiding, promoting and undertaking high quality research in the discipline of space sciences, to stimulate interest in space related studies. In addition he/she should undertake University teaching and publishing scholarly articles to disseminate knowledge.

Eligibility criteria:

- The Chair would be open to citizens of India
- Superannuated Scientists/Engineer/Academicians below age of 65 years on the day of notification.
- The tenure of the Chair will be for 3-years and will be renewed every year based on the Chair activities reviewed by the committee.
- Remuneration shall be fixed monthly amount of Rs. 70,000/- (consolidated)
- Additional expenditures such as communication, travel and other administrative expenses towards the promotional activities of space science will also be provided as per University norms.
