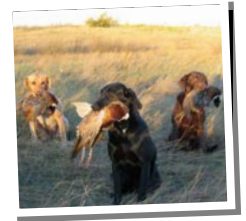




FIELD TESTS FOR ALL-AROUND HUNTING RETRIEVERS



NAHRA's purpose is to discover and reward dogs that can fulfill the hunter's needs in the field by performing in a manner consistent with the demands of actual hunting conditions.











Dogs are placed in categories based on ability not age.

Conservation of game through the development of trained retrievers.

The first organization dedicated to preserving hunting retriever skills.

- NAHRA, incorporated in 1984, is the originator of standards-based retriever field testing using realistic hunting scenarios.
- Dogs compete against a set of standards set forth in our rule book, not each other.
- Advanced titles require dogs to demonstrate proficiency in both upland and waterfowl work.
- Field tests are realistic, simulated hunting scenarios, with distances and conditions that hunters would encounter in the field.
- NAHRA supports clubs throughout the U.S. and Canada.

| <p>I N T E R M E D I A T E W R</p> <p>Intermediate dogs that pass the standard should be hunting dogs. They are obedient and have a good knowledge of hunting situations.</p> <p><i>Tests marks, blinds, upland hunting, and a trail.</i></p> |   <p><i>Develop an all-around upland and waterfowl hunter.</i></p> |
| <p>S E N I O R M H R</p> <p>The Senior test takes an Intermediate dog and adds training and experience. Senior dogs should be under complete control. They handle sharply and mark precisely.</p> <p><i>NAHRA MHRs are the elite of all hunting dogs.</i></p> |   <p><i>A dog you're proud to own and hunt anywhere.</i></p> |
