Dear Foundation staff:

As we begin the New Year, our hearts are full of gratitude for the significant financial support your foundation has provided to Sutter Solano Cancer Center patients. Thank you for helping us meet some of the financial challenges so many living with cancer must face.

As you are unable to see their tears of joy or feel the expression of heartfelt appreciation I wanted to report some of the circumstances related to their responses.

Costco gas cards were given to:

- Those driving an 81 year-old, widow living in Vacaville to radiation and chemotherapy
- A 70 year-old, retired man living in Rio Vista on a fixed income receiving chemotherapy
- An unemployed, 27 year-old, single mother living in Vacaville who received radiation
- A 76 year-old woman driving from Rio Vista for radiation treatments
- A 72 year-old woman living in Rodeo, with limited income, receiving radiation
- A 66 year-old man from Pinole receiving radiation whose limited income was being reduced for back child support
- A 72 year-old woman who drove from Vacaville for radiation and chemotherapy

Grocery cards were given to:

- A 72 year-old, widow on a fixed income with no family support
- A 68 year-old man living alone on a fixed income
- A 49 year-old, single mother with a dependent son at home, who had no food in the home and had just received a shut-off notice from PG & E
- A 71 year-old man with no income, with a large family, none of whom could help financially who received chemotherapy and radiation
- A 69 year-old, widow living on a fixed income who received radiation

In addition, your foundation assisted by making rent payments for two or three individuals and helped with other financial needs for them; helped a woman obtain a mobility device that was unavailable to her through her insurance; and, helped reduced debt, back car and insurance payments and provided additional support for a young, single mother.

Without exception, these individuals were extremely grateful for the help we provided through your foundation or that you gave to them directly. Being able to draw upon the support you have provided has been of great value in reducing their financial stress and has lightened the burdens they carry.

On behalf of those you have helped and from my staff I express our sincere thanks.
