June 28 through July 27, 2019

The Olive Hyde Art Guild is soliciting artists for its *Members Juried Show* that will run June 28 through July 27, 2019, at the Gallery. This show takes place every other year and is an exhibition of two and three-dimensional art held in Mission San Jose at the Olive Hyde Art Gallery, 123 Washington Boulevard, Fremont, CA. Submitted work may be in painting (oil, watercolor, acrylic), mixed media, photography, digital media (no video), ceramics, glass, sculpture, jewelry, fiber art, or works on paper. Judging for selection into the show will be done by a juror from digital images only. Awards will be decided by the juror from the actual artwork prior to the show opening.

Deadline for entering is Monday, May 20, 2019.

The Juror for the 2019 Show is photographer Keya Edwards. Currently, Keya is working with San Jose State University's College of Humanities & the Arts advising and facilitating Health & Safety in a variety of Arts Disciplines. Three monetary prizes will be awarded: Best of Show - \$250; 2nd Place - \$200; and 3rd Place - \$150. Merit Award winners will receive ribbons, and a Peoples' Choice ribbon will be voted by attendees at the Opening Night Reception.
