8. Unfinished Business

Update on FEMA

Mayor Stout stated that the city has been approved for FEMA funding to fix Rustic Drive at the low water bridge. The \$243,000 was approved restore Rustic Drive back pre-disaster condition, with an additional \$50,000 to install 6x6 box culverts. FEMA will pay 75% or approximately \$219,000.00. We will request bids. Hilltop and Dixieland are in FEMA consultation period for environmental and historical input for thirty days.

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Park update

The pavilion has been constructed and some final items are let to be completed. The Mayor will present to the council in the future, a proposal for a side walk from the parking lot at the basketball court to the parking lot at the playground. The Mayor is getting cost for updating the Park sign.

9. New Business

The Mayor presented the resignation letter of Council member Greg Sapp. Mr. Sapp has sold his house in Little Flock and will be moving out of the area. Applications from interested parties to fill the open position will be accepted, and the City Council will interview those applicants at the May work session on Monday, 14th, and make an appointment at the May 21st Council meeting.




