- **\$1,100 School Messenger / Remind App (provisional approval for 2019-20 Budget)-Approved**
 - Need to keep this program because Konstella doesn't send notifications when kids are late, sick or absent.
 - May be less than \$1100 looking at options
- **\$300 Chess in the Schools (revision to 2019-20 Budget) - Approved**
 - 25 years at PS 130
 - 3rd Grade has fall and spring instruction in class
 - After school program open to 4th and 5th grade
 - Parents receive information early September
 - 20 students plus a teacher. This year the teacher is Ms. Menon
 - Mandatory weekend tournaments
