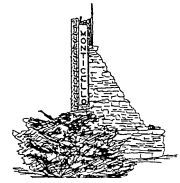




# VILLAGE OF MONTICELLO RECYCLING CENTER AND REFUSE PICK-UP INFORMATION



## RECYCLING CENTER LOCATION & HOURS

Monticello Recycling Center is located at 406 N Main St. behind the Swiss Heritage Cheese Factory.

### THE HOURS OF OPERATION ARE:

Wednesday from 4pm to 7pm and Saturday from 8am to 12pm

### THE RECYCLING CENTER IS FOR VILLAGE RESIDENTS ONLY NO SORTING NECESSARY!

#### **EXPANDED Paper RECYCLING**

- Cardboard (empty & flattened)
- Catalogs, Magazines & Phone books
- Cereal & cracker boxes (empty & flattened)
- Computer & office paper
- Envelopes & junk mail
- Holiday gift wrapping paper (no foil)
- Newspapers (including all inserts)
- Paper egg cartons
- Paper grocery bags
- Paper milk and juice cartons or boxes (remove caps and straws)
- Pizza boxes (no food or grease)
- Shredded paper (place in clear or transparent plastic bag and tie shut)
- Toilet paper & paper towel tubes

#### **EXPANDED Plastic RECYCLING**

- All plastic bottles (motor oil must be drained)
- Plastic containers/cups #1,2,4,5,7
- Tubs (margarine, sour cream, yogurt)



#### **RECYCLABLE Metal & Glass**

- Aerosol cans (empty – no paint or pesticide)
- Aluminum cans & aluminum pie plates; foil – rinsed clean
- Glass bottles & jars (clear, blue, brown or green translucent glass – rinsed clean)
- Metal pots & pans
- Tin & steel cans
- Brake rotors/ drums (metal dumpster)
- Glassware & Ceramics (fill pile only)

#### **NON-RECYCLABLE Items:**

- NO PLASTIC BAGS, film or Styrofoam
- Appliances or Electronics
- Frozen food or microwave dinner plates
- Mirrors and windows
- Pesticides – take to Green County Landfill
- Sharps or inhalers
- Napkins, paper towels, tissue, paper plates or waxed paper
- Light bulbs, hangers, plastic flower pots and flats
- Misc.: Carpet, clothing, diapers, fishing line, food, hoses, ropes, shoes, license plates, pipe or tubing

**RECYCLING Tips:** Do not place smaller items inside larger containers. All items should be loose and empty. Remove all food waste, plastic, styrofoam & packing peanuts. Flatten cardboard, cereal boxes and plastic containers to make room in the dumpsters.

#### **RESIDENTIAL REFUSE PICK-UP**

Refuse pick-up is every Tuesday. Refuse needs to be placed curbside by 7am. In 30 gallon clear or white bags or smaller weighing no more than 40# each. Each bag must have a \$2.50 refuse sticker attached. Stickers are available at the Village Hall or the Recycling Center during regular operating hours.

Burning of dry paper only is allowed in burn barrels at least 25' from any structure and must have a screen on top. Burning allowed daily from 6am to 6pm except on Sundays.
