You must be in full Class "A" uniform, including merit badge sash, when appearing before your Board of Review. Bring your Boy Scout Handbook and this sheet with the appropriate blank(s) filled in. The following are the minimum requirements for this Scout rank. In addition, you may be asked questions about or to demonstrate your proficiency of the requirements for the rank of Scout, Tenderfoot, Second Class, First Class and Star. A thorough review of the applicable portions of your Boy Scout Handbook will prepare you for your board.

1. Repeat the Scout Oath and Law.
2. Be prepared to describe the Scout Badge.
3. Explain Scout Spirit and give an example of how you have demonstrated Scout Spirit recently.
4. Give a brief account of your service project work hours. These projects must be approved by your Scoutmaster. (This must be one or more service projects totaling at least 6 hours of work.)
5. There is a major difference between the service required for Star and Life and that required for Eagle. In the first two, you can be a follower. For Eagle, you must be a leader. You must plan, develop and give leadership to a project of help to your church, school or community. The project must be of value when finished. Explain to the board why you feel you are now prepared to begin an Eagle project.
6. Give a brief account of your accomplishments in your Leadership Position of:
