PARSHAT HASHAVUA - WEEKLY TORAH PORTION
The Parshah in a Nutshell

B'Shalach

Exodus 13:17-17:16



Soon after allowing the children of Israel to depart from Egypt, Pharaoh chases after them to force their return, and the Israelites find themselves trapped between Pharaoh's armies and the sea. G-d tells Moses to raise his staff over the water; the sea splits to allow the Israelites to pass through, and then closes over the pursuing Egyptians. Moses and the children of Israel sing a song of praise and gratitude to G-d.

In the desert the people suffer thirst and hunger, and repeatedly complain to Moses and Aaron. G-d miraculously sweetens the bitter waters of Marah, and later has Moses bring forth water from a rock by striking it with his staff. He causes manna to rain down from the heavens before dawn each morning, and quails to appear in the Israelite camp each evening.

The children of Israel are instructed to gather a double portion of manna on Friday, as none will descend on Shabbat, the divinely decreed day of rest. Some disobey and go to gather manna on the seventh day, but find nothing. Aaron preserves a small quantity of manna in a jar, as a testimony for future generations.

In Rephidim, the people are attacked by the Amalekites, who are defeated by Moses' prayers and an army raised by Joshua.

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE FROM ROMITI STREET (edited) FROM "THE YOUNG ISRAEL OF LAVAL BULLETIN" APRIL 1961

The crocuses and trilliums are out and the birds are back in numbers. We can almost feel the earth stirring, pushing upwards into the air, and bursting into song. Spring is here at last – say goodbye to the dreary winter!!

A new feature has begun to appear on the landscape- an artificial crocus of cement, wood and steel. **YES IT'S OUR NEW SYNAGOGUE RISING OUT OF THE GROUND ON ELIZABETH STREET!!**

I feel as if I'm the owner of each yard of cement, each piece of wood, and each piece of steel. **DON'T YOU ??**

Imagine having our own place for Executive Board Meetings, Congregation, Sisterhood, Men's Club, and Youth Meetings, a place for Sisterhood Bazaars , a School and the Talmud Torah!! A place for Weddings, Bar Mitzvas, and many other celebrations! A place to meet with the Rabbi, and an office for the receipt of pledges and money!

As the building is rising higher excitement is mounting – I even saw a ripple of emotion on the faces of our unbelieving members. Indeed there is a stirring in the air. New members, new pledges, and increased payments of old pledges are coming in, and The Dedication Book Campaign has started off full steam. Negotiations with the United Talmud Torahs to have them take over the teaching of our Children commencing September 1961 have been concluded and a contract will be signed in a few days. Hall rentals for affairs after September 1961 may be applied for now. The new building should be completed by August 1961 and is proceeding on schedule.
