The Parshah in a Nutshell

Behaalotecha

Numbers 8:1–12:16



Moses appoints 70 elders

Aaron is commanded to raise light in the lamps of the menorah, and the tribe of Levi is initiated into the service in the Sanctuary.

A "Second Passover" is instituted in response to the petition "Why should we be deprived?" by a group of Jews who were unable to bring the Passover offering in its appointed time because they were ritually impure. G-d instructs Moses on the procedures for Israel's journeys and encampments in the desert, and the people journey in formation from Mount Sinai, where they had been camped for nearly a year.

The people are dissatisfied with their "bread from heaven" (the manna), and demand that Moses supply them with meat. Moses appoints 70 elders, to whom he imparts of his spirit, to assist him in the burden of governing the people. Miriam speaks negatively of Moses, and is punished with leprosy; Moses prays for her healing, and the entire community waits seven days for her recovery.

Monday morning June 5th saw the start of the war between Israel and their Arab neighbours. Monday evening of the same day, we here in Chomedey started a joint effort to aid our Brothers and Sisters in Israel.

Larry Rosenthal called an emergency meeting which was held at the Shaar Shalom Synagogue. Invited were the executives of our Synagogue, Chomedey Lodge of B'nai Brith, Laval Lodge of the Knights of Pythias and the Shaar Shalom. It was decided that we all would work together as a unit. Headquarters of this "Emergency Campaign" would be the Young Israel Synagogue. Under Larry's leadership, and together with Norman Shapiro, meetings were held every single evening with representatives of the four bodies attending.

Our Synagogue was represented by Rabbi Solomon Spiro, Maurice Boxer, A. Altman, N. Shapiro, Morris Winer, M. Rappaport, E. Leventhal, M. Kader, Arnold Kostiner, and I. Kaufman.

The Shaar Shalom was represented by Rabbi D. Auerbach, S. Gazin, A. Gorin, J. Mintzberg, and M. Hitterman.

Chomedey Lodge B'nai Brith was represented by D. Ichelson, J. Caplan, B. Kastner, M. Grill, A. Luther, P. Goldig and Gerry Rubin.
