Subject: **Happy Valley & Airport Signal Project**

Dear Property Owner:

Next week our contractor will start work installing a new traffic signal at the intersection of Happy Valley & Airport roads.

The work will be done in two phases. The first phase will occur in late June, and will consist of removing the existing overhead flashing beacon, and installing underground conduits and pole bases for the new signal. The second phase should occur later this summer, and will consist of installing the new signal poles, mast arms, signal heads, and cabinet. Each phase will take about two weeks to complete. The project will not include any new lanes or pavement widening.

Most of the work will take place on the shoulder of the road, without a permanent road closure or detour. The contractor will occasionally have to temporarily close a lane, in which case flaggers will be used to control the traffic.
