SCHOOL UNIFORM

Please, remember that all students from JK to Grade 8 must wear the school uniform. Please, refer to the website for the complete uniform policy. Uniforms must be worn the first day of school. Any student who is out of uniform will be sent home – No excuses will be accepted. Uniforms may be purchased from T-shirt Company of Windsor (1276 Ottawa St.).

MILK PROGRAM

The school offers a milk program for both 2% white & chocolate. Students may purchase milk on a daily basis or join the monthly milk program. The cost of milk is \$1.25 per carton.



EARLY DISMISSAL

If your child has an appointment or needs to leave early, please notify the office ahead of time and we will get your child ready for you. Please, remember that you must come in and sign out your child.



SCHOOL HOURS

Please note that the school hours for students are from 8:45 AM until 3:45 PM. Any student who remains after 4:00 PM will be placed in the afterschool care program and parents will be charged for the service.

LATE TO CLASS

The school day begins at 8:45 AM with the morning assembly. After 8:45 AM, any student arriving will be marked as late. Students are expected to be on time and prepared for each period. They must be in class in complete uniform with all the required books and materials. Lateness is detrimental to the students' progress. Lateness also causes a distraction of the class and is disrespectful to the teacher and students in the classroom. Being late, your child is losing valuable learning time. Excessive tardiness will result in consequences.



HOT LUNCH

The school will have snacks and lunch items available on a daily basis. Hot lunches will be sold every Friday beginning **September 13, 2019.** A Friday lunch notice will be sent home every Wednesday and to be returned Thursday to the your child's teacher. **NO HOT LUNCH ORDERS WILL BE ACCEPTED IN THE OFFICE.**



PEANUT / NUT FREE

An-Noor School is a peanut nut free school. Please, make sure you do not send any food products containing peanuts or other nuts with your child(ren).



CURRICULUM NIGHT

There will be a school curriculum night on **Thursday, September 19, 2019 from 6:00 PM until 8:00 PM**. We encourage all parents to attend this important event. This evening is strictly for parents to discuss and understand the curriculum being taught in the school over the school year. Teachers will be available to answer questions concerning curriculum being taught **ONLY**.



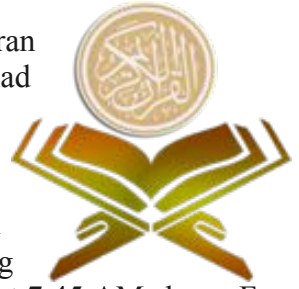
DROP OFF/PICK UP

The school will be open at 8:30 AM for students to enter. At 8:30 AM students should proceed to the gym to the class line. Students arriving before 8:30 AM will be sent to the before school care program incurring fees. Students can be dropped off at the front office entrance or in the back at the gym doors. After 8:45 AM, once the gym doors are closed, all students must be dropped off at the front office entrance. For dismissal time for parents picking up children from the back parking lot, we ask the parents please remain in their cars, alert the staff member/authorized volunteer on duty of the children being picked up, and we will bring your children out to you. If you are picking up your child(ren) from the front of the school, you must enter the school and provide your name to the front office. Children will be called to the front lobby where you will be waiting to receive them.



TAHFEETH PROGRAMS

Please note that the Tahfeeth ul Quran classes with Sheikh Mohamad Mahmoud (Iman of WIA Mosque) will begin on **Monday, September 16 from 7:45 AM until 8:45 AM** in the school Musalla. The program will run for one hour every morning from Monday to Thursday, starting at 7:45 AM sharp. For students enrolled this year, the Sheikh will conduct an interview before final registration is confirmed in the program. Since spots are limited, the deadline for registration is **Friday, September 13, 2019**.



Please note that the full-time Tahfeeth program with Sheikh Mohamad Abu Ras will begin on Tuesday, September 3rd from 8:45 AM to 3:45 PM. Students registered in this program will be in full and regular attendance.
