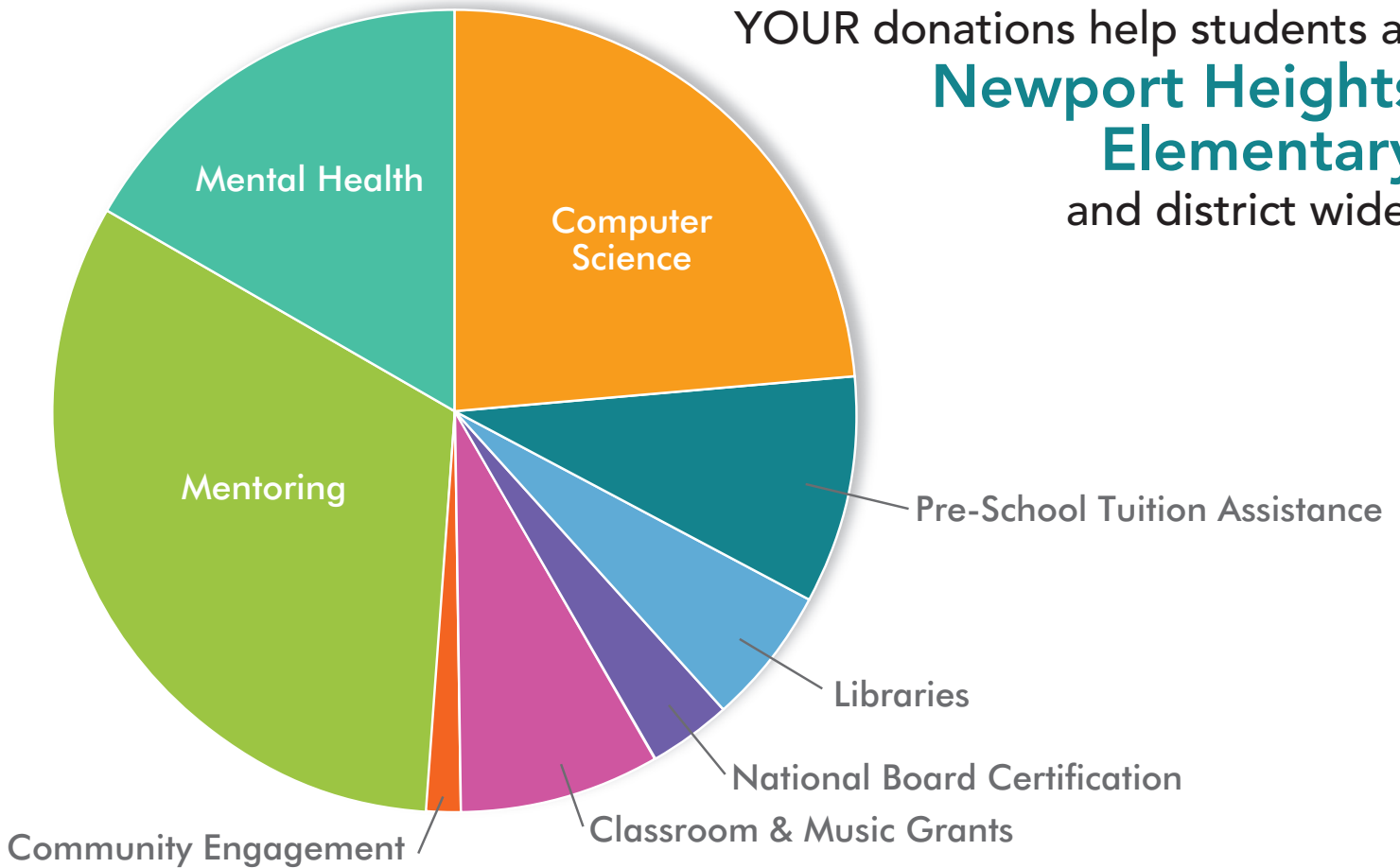




Bellevue Schools Foundation, will invest **\$1 MILLION** in our schools this year!
