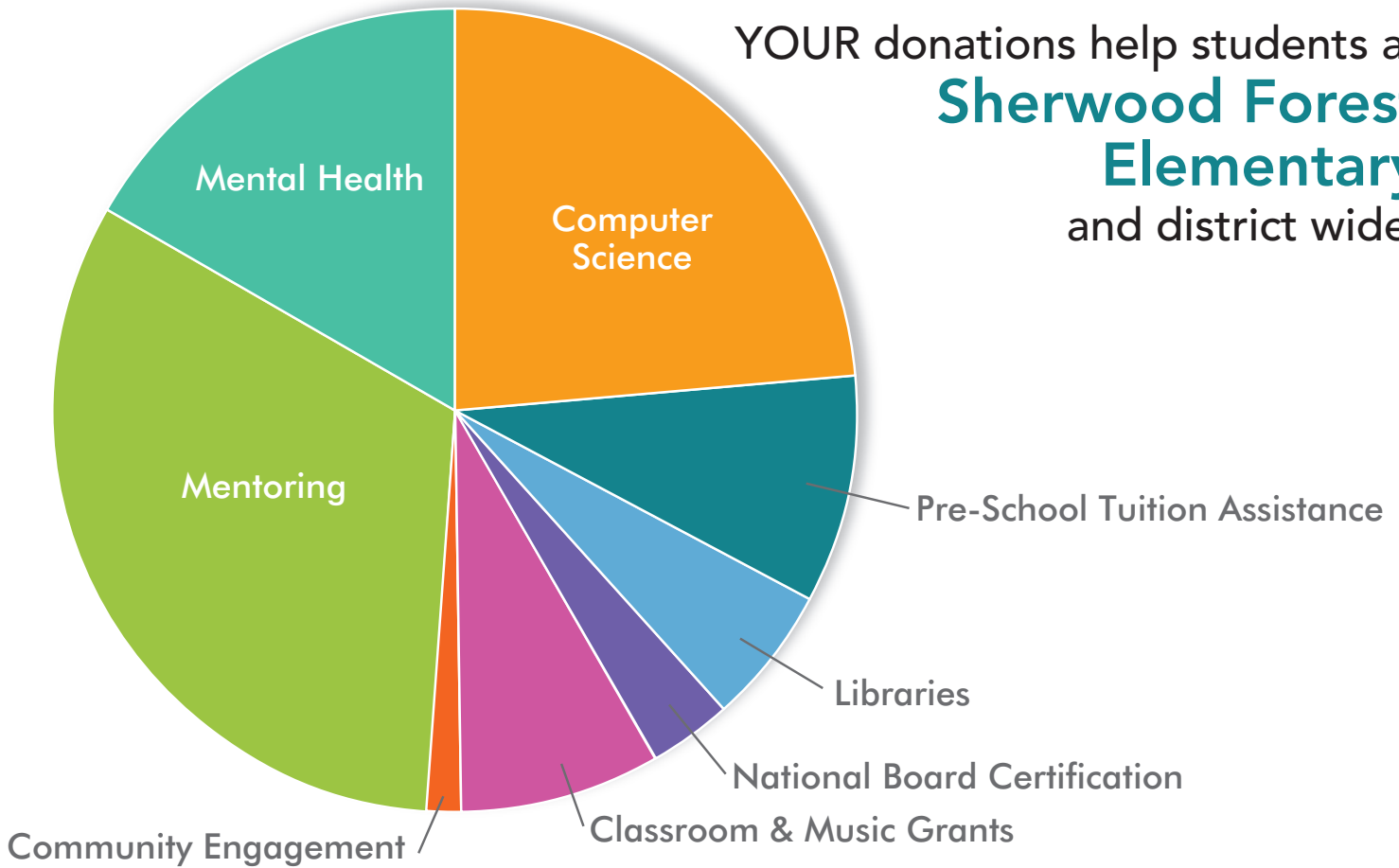




Bellevue Schools Foundation, will invest **\$1 MILLION** in our schools this year!

- Inspiring visits from local authors for every grade level brought reading to life.
- 4th graders learned stories of Washington and the Snoqualmie Tribe through a traveling museum.
- A theatrical performance in each 3rd grade class of an immigrant family's experience at Ellis Island.
- A theatrical performance in each 4th grade class on the impact of the gold rush on the Pacific Northwest.
- A theatrical performance in each 5th grade class on the experience of a Black soldier in the American Revolution.
- A bilingual school performance of a powerful story of *The Upside Down Boy/El Nino de Cabeza*.
- Multicultural library books were purchased to reflect characters and situations that students can identify with.
