We have reserved "The Boat Launch" group area for our event. It's a private fenced-in area along the 3rd base line that can accommodate up to 125 people and sign-up is on a first come-first served basis. Below are the details:

- Date: **Wednesday, July 18, 2018**. First pitch: 6:35 pm. Picnic buffet is from 6:05 pm - 7:35 pm.
- Ticket cutoff date is **Sunday, June 24**, unless the 125 maximum is reached before this date.
- Cost: \$23.00/person. Ages 3-10: \$18.00/person. Ages 2 & Under: FREE.
- What does this price include? Your game ticket plus an all-you-can-eat picnic buffet with hamburgers, brats, hot dogs, chips, baked beans and 2 drink tickets (beer, soda or water). Gates open and the picnic starts 30 minutes before the game and food is available for 1 ½ hours.
- Corn Hole, Ping-Pong & Giant Connect 4 can also be played in the grassy area.
- Seating: Picnic tables with umbrellas. You can also carry-in your own umbrellas, blankets and attachable stadium chairs.
- Sign-up sheets, payment box and additional details are posted in the narthex.
- Wristbands (for the game, food and drinks) will be handed out prior to or at the game.
