More than 400 parents, 150 volunteers, local businesses and multiple companies supported the event and a great day of fun and excitement was had by all.

In China, Captivating supports multiple projects ranging from educational support for girls who have missed schooling, through to helping entire villages end poverty through animal husbandry, clean water, solar panels, greenhouses, and other solutions. 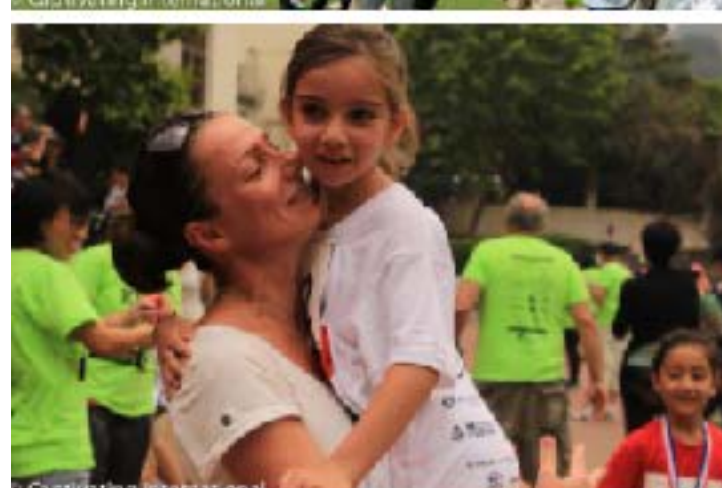

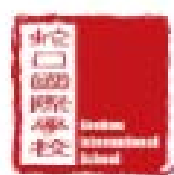
