Like the simple robes of the Dominican brothers who were the caretakers of the missions, Mission Cloth is produced with the most basic of all weaves. However, the yarn in both directions is a unique blend of linen, cotton and viscose, providing a very subtle texture and beautiful modulation of color. The eight colors of Mission Cloth range from a stunning greyed white called Oyster to rich saturated hues like Violet, Yarrow and Deep Water. In every case, two colors are combined, making the fabric more complex and interesting. Mission Cloth is ideal for any style of upholstery as well as draperies, walls and headboards.
