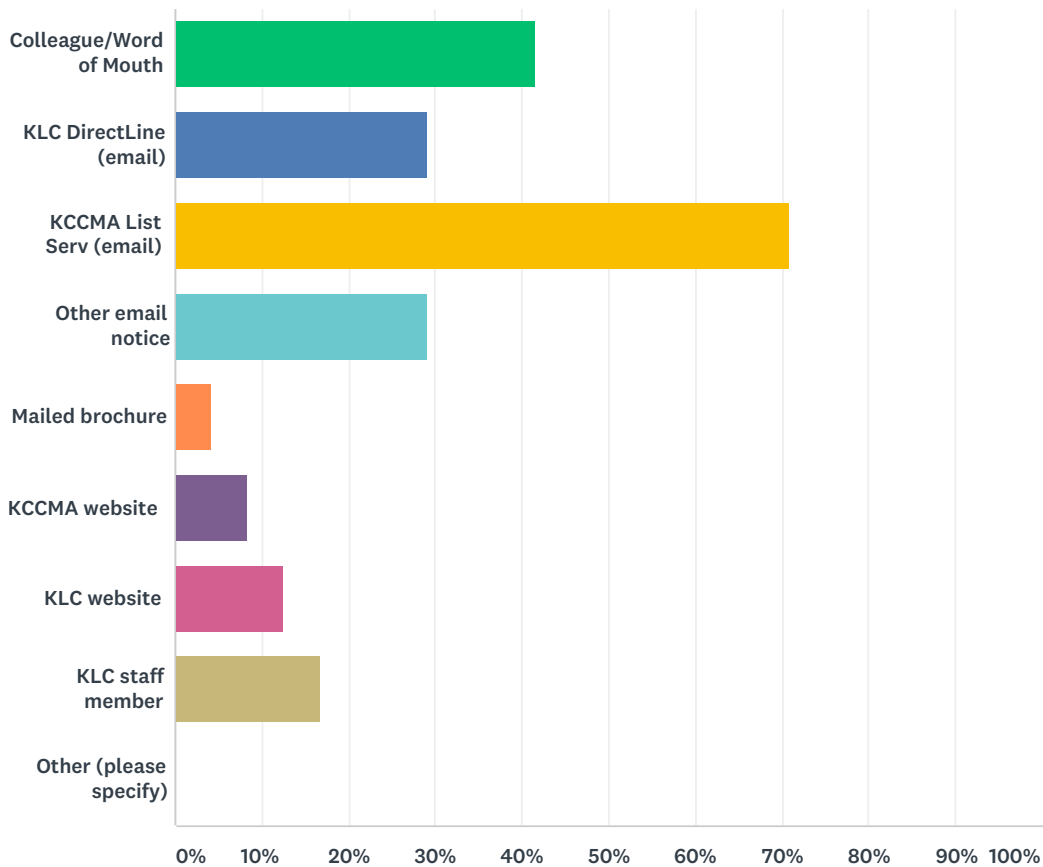


Q1 How did you get information about the 2019 KCCMA Conference? (Check all that apply.)

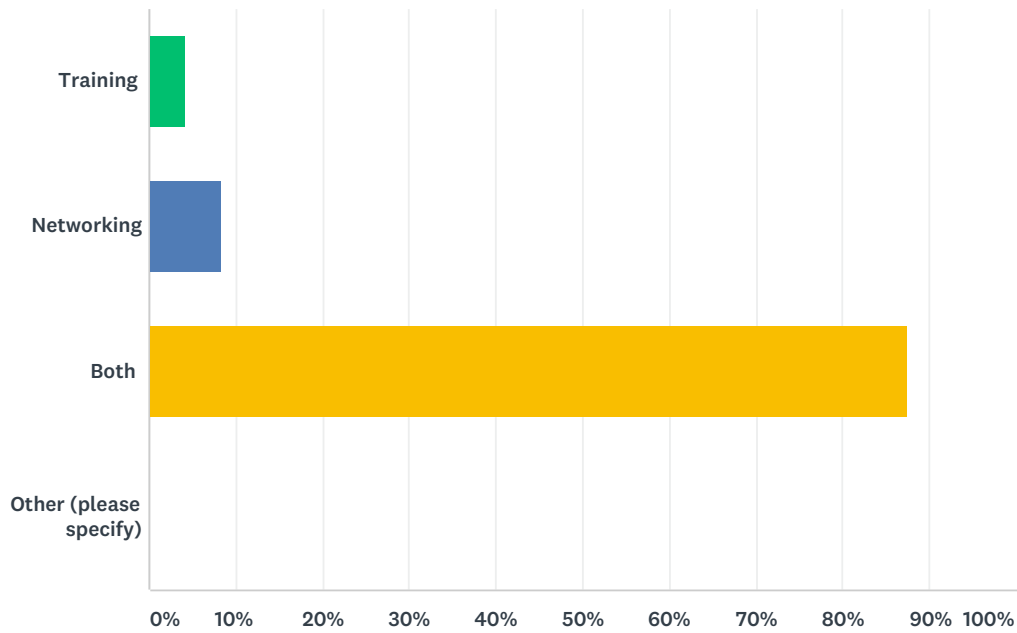
