### ***Program Description:***

YouthBuild is a 450-hour training program where students will learn a wide range of skills from site inspection and controlled demolition to carpentry and painting.

You will work on:

- Construction and rehabilitation of Baltimore City homes
- Skills in site inspection, demolition, painting, and carpentry
- Giving presentations about what you've learned
- Community service projects

During this program, you will also get the following support:

- \$510 (before taxes) bi-weekly stipend
- \$1,566.14 education award upon program completion
- Job development opportunities
- Educational Support

- Home Builders Institute certifications

### ***What do entry-level Construction Workers do?***

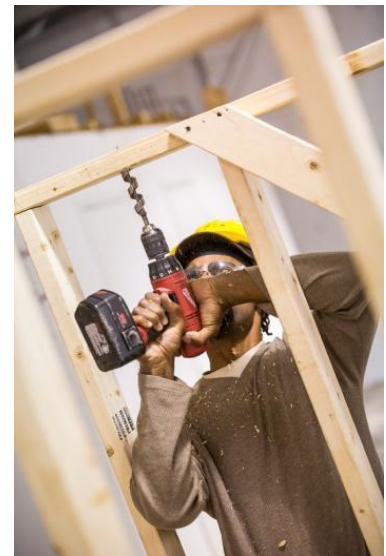
Graduates of YouthBuild find employment in entry-level construction jobs. On the job, you will likely work on setting up and cleaning up jobsites, helping skilled laborers on the job, working with tools of the trade, painting buildings and homes, remodeling, and demolition. Depending on the job, you will have other tasks as well.

- Are willing to work up to 10 or more hours each day when needed

- Cannot maintain good attendance and be on time
- Need to earn money and credentials fast – promotions and licensing can take 4 years
- Are not able to pass a drug test

***To be admitted to this program, you must:***

- Pass a math and reading test
- Complete an application
- Work with an intake specialist through Civic Works

*Note: Nearly all jobs in construction will require you to pass a drug test before starting work. Many employers need their workers to move from job site to job site, and not all sites are in Baltimore City.*
