### ***Program Description:***

The Maritime, Transportation, Distribution & Logistics (MTDL) training program has been designed in cooperation with the Port of Baltimore and employers in MTDL industries. In this training, you will complete a three-week (90 hour) training course that will help you with:

- Skills training for the Maritime, Transportation, Distribution & Logistics fields
- Help with earning certifications to prepare you for various careers in the MTDL industries at the Port of Baltimore and other regional sites
- General career support (such as dealing with issues that could keep you from getting and keeping a job, career counseling, and ongoing support)
- General job readiness training

In this program, you will receive at least one year of ongoing employment assistance and post-employment support, including additional chances to earn certifications to help you keep your job and advance in your career. You can also receive general computer software training in Microsoft Office.

### ***Credential or Certification Earned:***

Depending on your individual career path and skill levels, you can obtain various certifications, such as:

- Transportation Workers Identification Card (TWIC)
- Forklift and OSHA-10 certifications
- Warehouse Inventory Control Specialist certification
- Certified Customs Specialist certification

### **Potential Job Titles:**

Forklift Operator, Warehouse Associate, Order Puller, Packer, Production Worker, Inventory Specialist, Assembly Worker, Logistics Administrator

- Assembling materials
- Making sure products in a warehouse are stored and moved correctly
