As an arts community we thrive and enjoy working together in a variety of ways. One of those ways may be requesting to borrow or use our equipment, costumes or space. We love the ability to work together to share resources. As small businesses and non-profits, we often do not have the needed resources, and the ability to share amongst ourselves has been an incredible benefit to all of us. As we want to continue to work together in all endeavors, we have taken this down time during COVID and our move to our new home, to re-evaluate how we lend what we have.

In the past, we have organized the lending of resources through a single executive member or two and this has resulted in some surprises along the way. We are simply changing the process to include the entire executive, which will allow for everyone to be aware. We are now requiring any rental or lending requests to be presented to the executive. We meet on the second Wednesday of each month, excluding July and August when we take a break. With those dates in mind, it is important to submit your request in a timely manner to avoid disappointment.

This new requirement is being implemented to review each request or proposal in line with the purpose of keeping track of our assets that are and in themselves, a significant expense to Streetlight.
