Section 314 of the CRRSAA and ARP programs requires institutions to make public each calendar quarter the reporting of the student grant funds given to the student body. In compliance with the above,

1) Parisian Spa Institute signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used the applicable amount of funds designated under the program to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.

2) The total amount of funds the institution has received from the Department pursuant to the Institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the CRRSAA and ARP (a) (1) and (a) (4) programs is \$134084.00

3) The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under the CRRSAA and ARP programs as of the date of submission is \$134084.00

4) The estimated total number of students at the institution that are eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the CRRSAA and ARP programs is: 132

5) The total number of students who have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students under the CRRSAA and ARP programs is: 132 given checks, with 4 checks not cashed.

6) The method used by institution to determine which students receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants and how much they would receive under the CRRSAA and ARP (a) (1) and (a)(4) programs: 1) We divided the number of students equally across the board regardless of program, as not all programs qualified for Pell giving each student \$1,264.94 each. A balance of \$2529.88 was left and divided amongst the new students 28 of them for a check of \$90.35

7) Any instructions, directions, or guidance provided by the Institution to students concerning the Emergency Financial Aid Grants:

1) Students are to use the grant funding to help with housing, food, medical bills, including mental health needs and or childcare. Students may utilize funding to pay off school debt balances as long as he or she signs authorizing grant funds to be used for those purposes.
