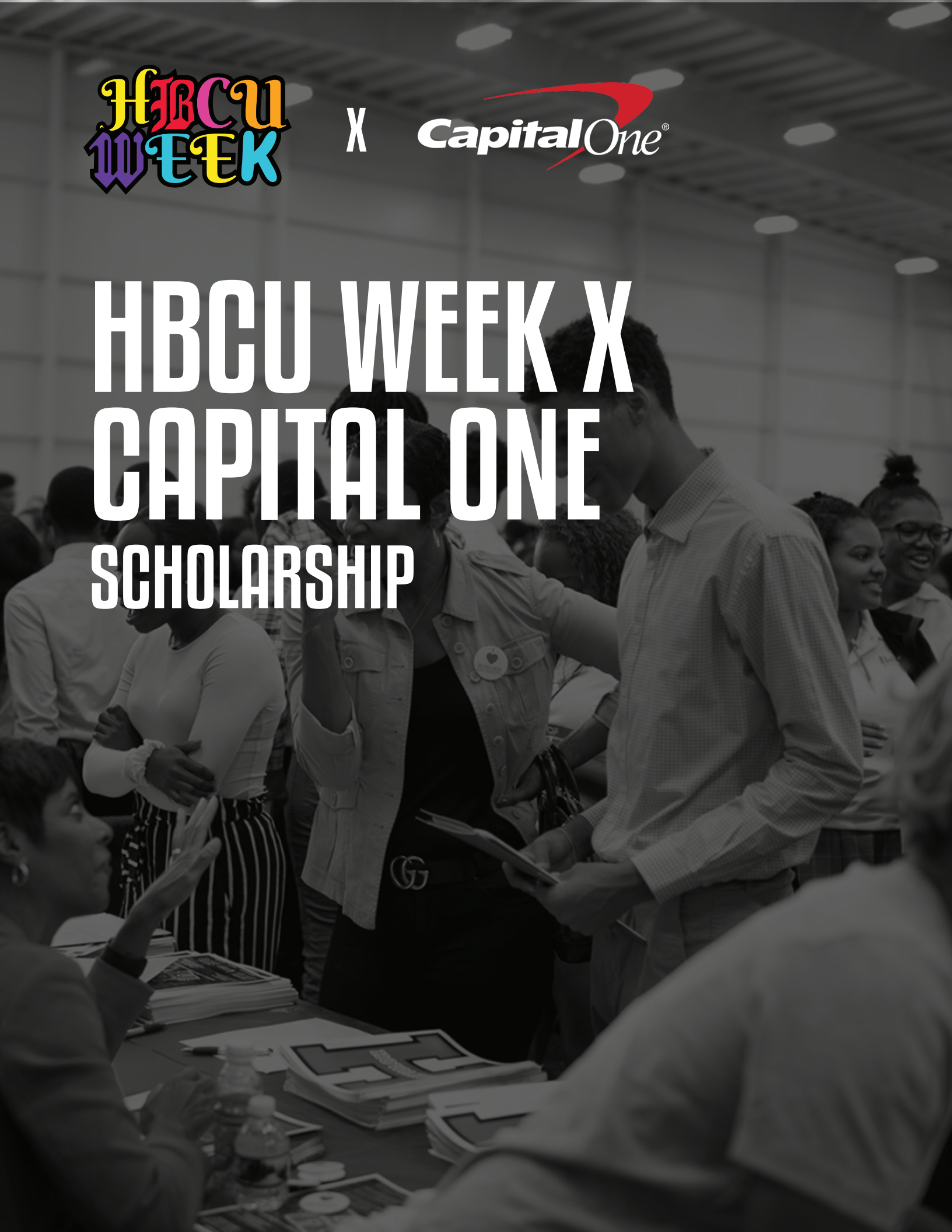

PROCESS

Potential scholarship recipients must complete a scholarship application and email it to the scholarship administrator at Scholarship@HBCUWeek.org along with all supporting documentation by the established deadline of February 15, 2021. Scholarship decisions will be made by Spring 2021.

CRITERIA

- Applicants must be completing or have completed high school successfully with a minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicants must be accepted as a full-time student at an HBCU for the upcoming academic semester.
- Applicants must be a citizen or legal permanent resident of the United States.
- Applicants must complete and submit a scholarship application by February 15, 2021.

AWARD

The HBCU Week Foundation together with Capital One will form a committee and award the scholarship based on a comprehensive evaluation process.

Areas reviewed by the committee include but are not limited to the following:

- Academic accomplishments
- Reference letters
- Financial Need
- Community involvement

The HBCU Week Foundation will pay the scholarship directly to the HBCU

This is a one-time, \$10,000.00 scholarship award

SCHOLARSHIP ADMINISTRATION

The HBCU Week Foundation committee will lead the process of receiving and reviewing applications, selecting recipients, and making scholarship awards. The committee working together will read applications, determine the best candidates and then vote for approval. We will then notify the recipients and award the scholarship funds via phone call and an official letter.
