Junior Jamboree-Taught by Amber-This class is for potty-trained students aged 3-5 years old. Parent accompaniment is not necessary for this hour long class chock full of stories, rhymes, silly dances, wacky games, and lots of musical educational FUN! Students will sing, play hand instruments, acts out songs and stories, and enjoy themselves while laying the ground for a lifetime of enjoying music and language.

SONGWRITING-Taught by Marielle-This class is for the musician who has played other people's music, but has not yet created something themselves or has limited experience doing so. Musicians who have already written songs and need more inspiration or a different outlook to spark their writers block are welcome as well. Student should already know how to play an instrument and be able to follow basic musical instruction as an individual. This class is designed for older students or more mature musicians. Young adults, adults, and teenagers are welcome.

MUSIC THEORY I-Taught by Lauren-Music Theory is the underlying language of music. When you understand what is going on within the mechanics of music, you can understand and manipulate it in ways never imagined before. This class is designed for students who are curious about how music works, students **who are preparing for a collegiate career in music and need to brush up on their skills**, or for musicians who need to dig deeper within the roots of their knowledge of music to find inspiration or better understand music from another musical activity. This class will suit the students who sign up for it and give these students a strong foundation to bring to their college musical studies. Singers and instrumentalists alike, we all need to know theory. Get your head start here!

Chorus-Taught by Lauren, Heidi, and Derik- This class is for students who have never taken lessons, or who have taken a minimal amount of lessons focusing on the vocal instrument. Student will first learn about the different kinds of voices, and how each are used within different genres of music. Student will learn how to breathe properly, how to carry their voice with a proper breath, and how to make their voices sound full and rich with specific vocal techniques. This class is open to students 8-18. This class will be full of fun with silly improvisation activities and fun wacky vocal warm-ups. Ever sing with your tongue sticking out? You will here!

Mandolin from Scratch-Taught by Lee Stivers-Here is your chance to pick up that Mandolin you've been carting around and learn exactly what you need to explore any genre and style you want. Lee Stivers has been studying blues, bluegrass, and roots style mandolin for the past 10 years and has developed a class curriculum to teach you all you need to know to start plucking your favorite tunes. This class is designed for adults or mature young adults who take learning seriously. Lee will cover different strumming and chording styles, how to transpose songs to more comfortable keys, and how to keep up in the ever demanding jam session atmosphere. This is a **MUST HAVE** class for mandolin beginners and will quickly get you on your way.

String Ensemble -Taught by Lauren-This class is for the beginner string instrumentalist looking to connect with peers through the magic of an ensemble. Lauren creates a wildly fun, and hard working atmosphere to produce beautiful music that is both challenging for students but intrinsically motivating for personal growth. This is a great first time ensemble experience to gain the necessary musical independence and skills to work within a group.

WIND ENSEMBLE-Taught by Al-This class is designed for students who already have a good foundation in their instrument of choice. Musical selections will include a wide variety of genres and performance opportunities will include a special DMH concerts at the end of sessions and possibly some community performances.
