WHAT IS COVID-19 AND HOW DOES IT SPREAD?

Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) is a respiratory illness caused by a virus called SARS-CoV-2. Our understanding of how the virus spreads is evolving as we learn more about it, so check the CDC website for the latest information and current list of symptoms. The virus is thought to spread mainly from person to person:

- Between people who are in close contact with one another (within about 6 feet).
- Through respiratory droplets produced when an infected person coughs, sneezes, or talks.

Recent studies indicate that the virus can be spread by people who are not showing symptoms. It may be possible that a person can get COVID-19 by touching a surface or object that has the virus on it and then touching their own mouth, nose, or possibly their eyes. This is not thought to be the main way the virus spreads, but we are still learning more about this virus. Older adults and people of any age who have serious underlying medical conditions may be at higher risk for severe illness from COVID-19.

Public Interaction, Meetings, and Gatherings:

Where possible, we will limit public interaction to email, phone, or virtual meetings. Public events or meetings will be cancelled or postponed, or held via telepresence.

All protocols followed on site are actively updated based on current regulations and guidelines

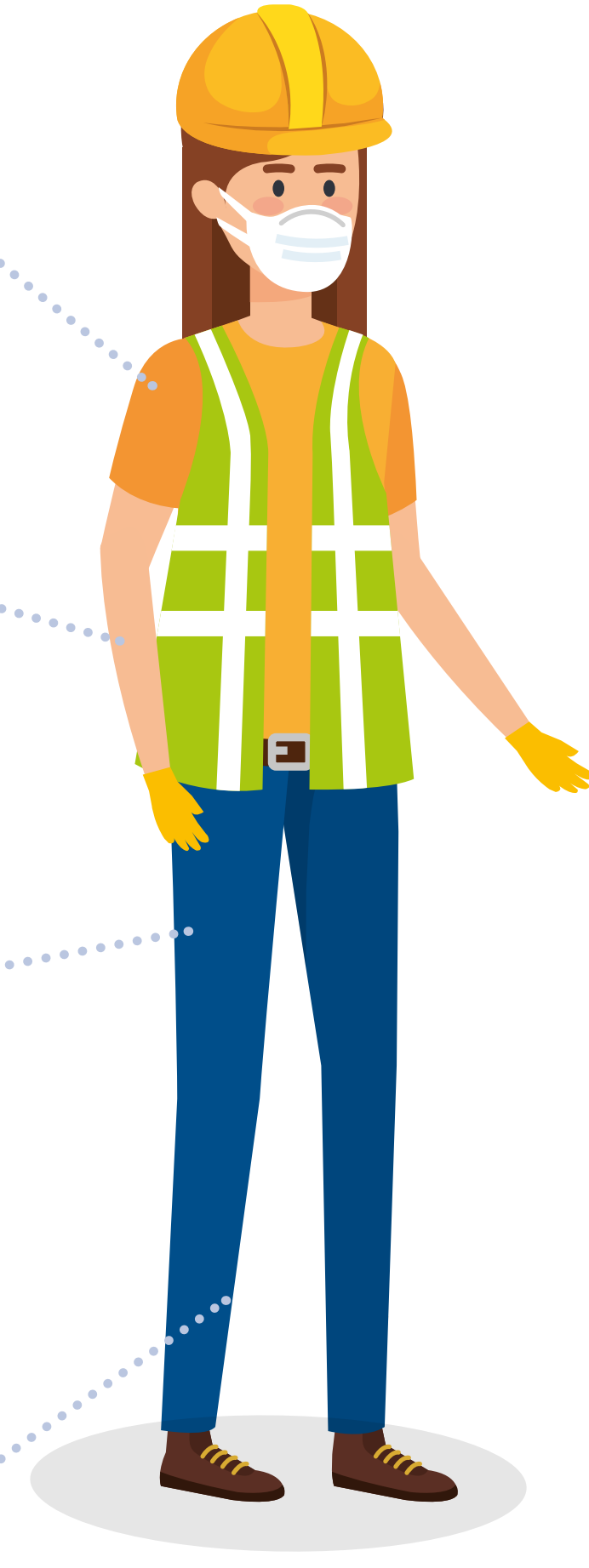

COVID-19 SPECIFIC SITE SAFETY PROTOCOLS



- ✓ **HEALTH SCREENING**
 - Morning temperature & health screening
 - Daily self-assessments
 - Isolation protocols in place for workers with symptoms
- ✓ **PHYSICAL DISTANCING**
 - 6ft distancing at all times
 - Avoid congregating in breaks/trailers
 - Only essential personnel at site
- ✓ **PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT**
 - Face coverings worn 100% of time
 - Disposable gloves used when disinfecting or touching high-touch surfaces
- ✓ **HYGENE**
 - Portable hand wash stations at sites
 - Hand sanitizer available to workers
 - Sanitizing wipes available for wiping surfaces and common surfaces
 - Daily site cleaning
