ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

BY THE COURT:*

On or before 3:00 p.m. on Monday, June 28, 2021, petitioners shall serve and file amended exhibit volumes in full compliance with the foregoing rule.

Good cause appearing from the petition for writ of mandate/prohibition on file in this action,

IT IS ORDERED that respondent superior court show cause before this court **on July 15, 2021 at 9:00 a.m.**, why the relief requested in the petition should not be granted.

Real parties in interest shall serve and file a return to the petition **on or before July 2, 2021**. The reply to the return shall be served and filed **on or before July 9, 2021**. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 8.487(b).) The parties are hereby informed that no extensions of time are contemplated.

This order to show cause is to be served and filed on or before June 25, 2021. It shall be deemed served upon service by the clerk of this court of copies of this order to all parties to this proceeding and to respondent superior court.

The justices will be familiar with the facts and issues, will have conferred among themselves on the case, and will not require oral argument. Because of the public health emergency caused by the coronavirus pandemic, the court has ordered that all oral arguments take place by video conference at this time, although counsel should refer to the court's website for up to date information. If oral argument is requested, the request shall be served and filed **on or before July 2, 2021**. If no request for oral argument is filed on or before that date, the matter will be submitted at such time as the court approves the waiver and the time for filing all briefs and papers has expired. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 8.256(d)(1).) If oral argument is requested, this cause will be set for oral argument at the aforementioned date and time, namely July 15, 2021 at 9:00 a.m.
