EXECUTIVE BOARD REPORTS

President: Dena Knox

We currently have 132 QCLGA active members and 4 non active members. We have 46 participants in the Southern District, 91 in the RBC's, and 29 in the Hole In One Club. AGA needs to be advised of our current QCLGA Board Officers. Marie will work with the AGA for communication.

Past President/Robson Challenge: Jacquie Owens

Scheduled date for the 2021 Robson Challenge is set for Wednesday, November 17th 2021. Tentative shotgun start format at 10:00 a.m. The Crystal Ballroom has been reserved. Peg Avent has agreed to assist with the Robson Challenge. Additional volunteers will be identified as we get closer to the date.

Thirty rental carts will be available for 60 players. Will also need member carts as well. Follow-up meetings will occur in the summer to discuss tee times, carts (e.g. how/when to get member carts, cleaning before and after use.) Communication was sent to the representatives of the Robson Communities updating them on the current status. Robson Qualifying scores have been received and updated. Thank you Tournament Committee Team! The Quail Creek team will be made up of twelve team members, flighted within a handicap range.

QCLGA Event Participation – QCLGA event participation continues to grow with an average of 60 players for our events this year. The “Lone Ranger” having the largest participation of 88 players. The Tournament Committee has been successful in our Pick Your Partner (PYP) events with getting partners for all our singles that have signed up for these type of events.

QCLGA Championship – Three Day Event -- Based on the feedback received from several of our ladies, they enjoyed playing in our three day event in spite of the challenging windy conditions. We had 51 ladies participate. We were able to pay out 51% of the field. The ladies liked that one player cannot be awarded money in both gross and net within their flights. Congratulations to: Bobbi Jo Rathvon – Overall Low Gross Winner and Kathy Linn – Overall Low

Net winner. Both ladies were awarded \$100 Robson Gift Cards. The QCLGA Board will evaluate whether to continue with this format next year or go back to two separate three day tournaments for our Club Championship and Presidents Cup.

QCLGA Team Challenge – Two Day Event. This is our first time running a two day- two team event using a Four Ball and Shamble Match Play format. 72 ladies participated. Positive feedback received and looking at doing this event again next year.

Give Back To The Community Event -- The Ladies 9-Hole organization has reached out to the QCLGA to start discussions on planning this upcoming event. The date set for this event is November 4th. Terri Bacon will be the designated Tournament Committee coordinator for this event.

QCLGA Outside Play-Days - Offsite play-days have been reserved during the Roadrunner course closure for June, July and August. San Ignacio and Tubac. The 2021 QCLGA calendar has been updated and posted on our web site to reflect these play days. Additional information will come out in the upcoming Golf Genius invites.

QCLGA Event Handicap Allowances -- The Tournament Committee has finalized documentation for handicap allowances to be used for all our events. These handicap allowances are in accordance with the World Handicap System (WHS) and the USGA. Additional documentation has been produced on how these handicap allowances will be applied to our all of our events.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Jan suggested when posted our scores to GHIN, we record our scores hole by hole for handicap purposes. We should have our scores verified by our playing partners before posting. The Handicap Committee does check tee sheets to make sure we are posting all our scores, when applicable. We do have some ladies signing up for AGA registration and sometimes do not want to play in the QCLGA. That would make them “inactive” players. The Handicap Committee will be verifying inactive vs active players.

RBC’S: Kris Weinberg

We currently have 91 members in the RBC’s. Noted: 111 Birdies and 99 Chip-ins

On April 27, a committee met to review the RBC General Information posted on the website and to make revisions in procedures. A review was suggested at the last Board meeting. The committee included Dena Knox, Deb Riddell, Bonny Wilcox and myself. The last revisions were in 2018. There were several reasons to consider changes at this time. Now the new World Handicap System allows us to score and post holes differently. The Tournament committee has changed the way they post Disqualified, Withdraw and Did Not Finish in our weekly games. The Review committee felt that players should still qualify for RBCs when in some cases they might not qualify for weekly winnings. An example is a Blind Nine game where a player might pick up not knowing which holes will count that day. They also agreed that scores without an X should be eligible for Ringers, even when some X’s may be recorded on that scorecard. It was decided that when a player picks up, a maximum score will be used in the Ringers Excel program on that hole, that day, as the player will more than likely have a lower score before or after this. Birdies and Chip-Ins

may still be recorded when "X's" are entered on the scorecard. The intent is make the information on the website clear to members.

The new wording for Ringers General Information posted on the website:

~~Ringers are eligible on QCLGA completed official ladies play day games, where the player individually plays her entire game, without a Withdrawal or being Disqualified.~~

Ringers are eligible on any QCLGA officially sanctioned postable game score at Quail Creek. This includes all play days, Member-Guest, etc. including Match Play. When an "X" is entered on a scorecard, a maximum score will be entered for Ringers on that hole as the player will more than likely have a lower score before or after this. Birdies and Chip-Ins may still be recorded when "X's" are entered on the scorecard.

Only completed rounds are entered. For an 18 hole score to be posted, at least 14 holes must be played.

The new wording for Birdies and Chip-Ins General Information posted on the website:

~~Birdies & Chip-Ins are eligible on QCLGA completed official ladies play day games, where the player individually plays her entire game, without a Withdrawal or being Disqualified.~~

Birdies & Chip-Ins are eligible on any QCLGA officially sanctioned postable game score at Quail Creek. This includes all play days, Member-Guest, etc. including Match Play. Birdies and Chip-Ins may still be recorded when "X's" are entered on the scorecard.

Only completed rounds are entered. For an 18 hole score to be posted, at least 14 holes must be played.

These revisions will be presented to members at the General Meeting May 20 and then posted on the website to replace current wording. Procedures for the RBC Coordinator will be updated and added to the coordinator's notebook.
