1. Roadrunner #4, no yellow penalty area in front of teeing area or behind the green and no drop area by the green. Red penalty area is still along the right side of the fairway. If your ball goes over the green, no longer a penalty area, play the ball as it lies.
2. Rip Rap/River Rock - no longer red penalty areas. All prepared rock will be considered an obstruction (i.e., cart path) and free relief. See attached copy of Prepared Rock information.
3. Quail #8, only Red Penalty Area - no longer Yellow Penalty Area.
