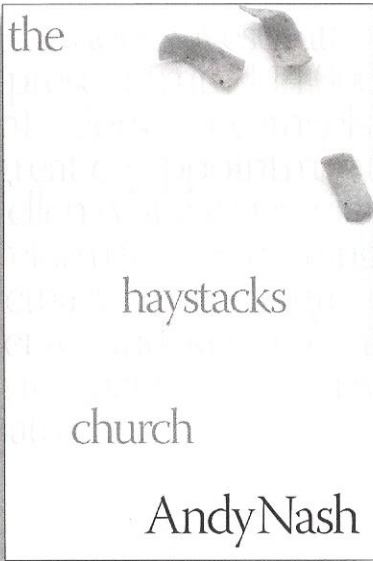


The Haystacks Church

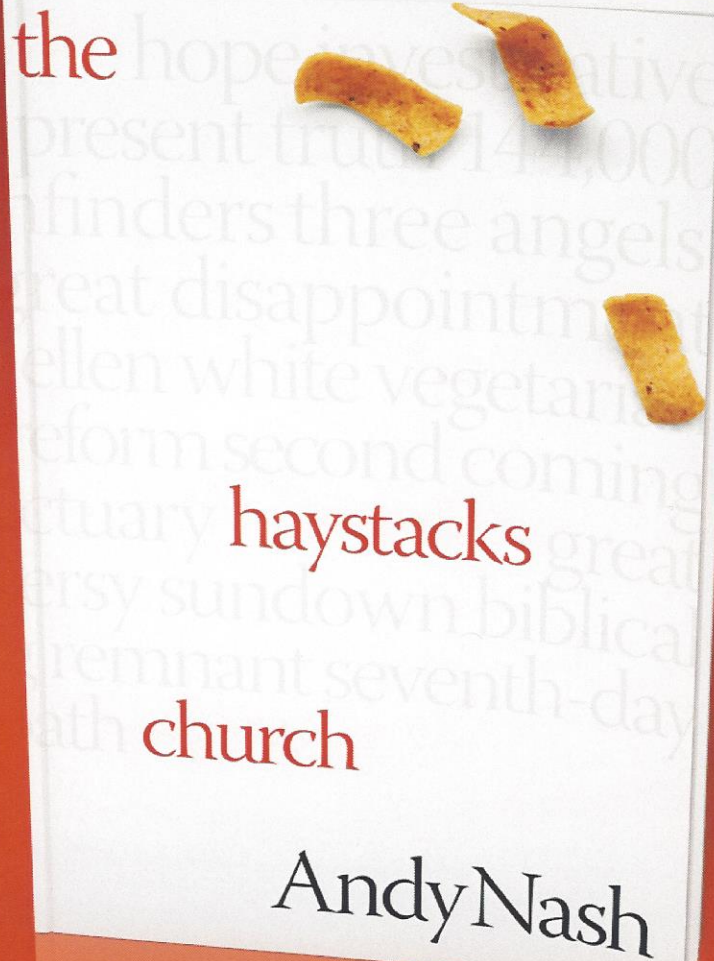
