- Window Safety
 - Evans Law (military housing)
 - Equip families/ military housing with window safety for new and existing homes (May 2018)
 - Working to implement window fall protection devices

New business

- Safe Haven- Dr. Pantell
 - Abandoned infants can be taken to fire station, police station, hospitals
 - 2007 safe haven laws: 3 days to turn baby in
 - Whoever receives baby, extensive medical history of infant needed
- Fire safety education
 - Purpose: Decrease the number of fires of youth children
 - Seek underlying issues to setting fires
 - Community awareness: youth mental health/youth training
 - Looking to enhance/ w partner agencies
- Stop the bleed
 - Stop the bleed campaign, bring community awareness, trainings provide “stop the bleed kit”
- EMS- Injury Prevention - Legislative/ institutional survey
- Dr. Violet Horvath gave an update on the Hawaii Neurotrauma Registry Project (HNTR), which provides a free information and referral service for Hawaii residents of all ages who have had a stroke, spinal cord injury, or traumatic brain injury. In addition they offer free presentations to groups of all ages. The project, which is funded by the Department of Health, also collects data from neurotrauma injury survivors on their post-injury needs.
