How to Make a Gift

Gift in Life

Offer a gift of cash, securities or other assets, such as real estate.

Bequest

Provide for loved ones, the Alisa Ann Ruch Burn Foundation and others through a provision in your will.

Revocable Living Trust

Control the distribution of your assets, including bequests to the Alisa Ann Ruch Burn Foundation, without going through probate.

Life Insurance

Make a large gift at a small cost of simply giving a new or existing policy designating the Alisa Ann Ruch Burn Foundation as a beneficiary.

Pooled Income Fund

An irrevocable gift to the Alisa Ann Ruch Burn Foundation allow you to receive an income for life a significant tax deduction. Upon death, the principal reverts to the Alisa Ann Ruch Burn Foundation.

Charitable Remainder Trust

Receive an income for life or a period of years, reduce your taxable estate and benefit your heirs and the Alisa Ann Ruch Burn Foundation with a gift of assets including cash, stocks or real estate.

Charitable Lead Trust

The Alisa Ann Ruch Burn Foundation will receive an income from an asset for a given period of years. The asset is later returned to you, a family member or other beneficiary.

Charitable Gift Annuity

Receive a fixed income for list and remove assets from your taxable estate with a gift of cash or securities.

Gift of Real Estate

The tax laws allow you to give the Alisa Ann Ruch Burn Foundation your personal residence and receive an immediate tax deduction, yet you and/or your spouse may continue to live there for the remainder of your lifetimes or for a set number of years.

Memorial Gift

Can be made through any of the instruments above by designating the gift in memory of a loved one.

The General Endowment

All unrestricted bequests are places in the Alisa Ann Ruch Burn Foundation general endowment. The income produced by this fund is used to augment the organization's annual income for programs and services.
