Education Requirements:

- Valid Nevada Teaching License in one area of Exceptional Education as needed that has never been revoked or suspended in this state or another state (Licensure type – Generalist)
- Minimum of three years successful teaching experience in Special Education
- Bachelor's Degree or higher in Special Education from an accredited educational institution

Community Requirements:

- Knowledge of statutes and regulations governing IDEA and special education law.
- Ability to work with a diverse population of students, staff, and parents

Knowledge Requirements:

- Experience using the **Infinite Campus** tracking and reporting system and data plans for IEPs
- Knowledge of **CCSD Special Education** policies and procedures, IDEA, NRS/NAC and FERPA
- Knowledgeable in the use of data tracking systems such as AIMSWEB, ezCBM and NWEA Map.

- Experience, knowledge and support of non-traditional educational programs
- Desire to serve students
- Passion for school improvements to focus on diverse learners.
- Experience with confidential information
- Experience working with children
- Ability to communicate effectively with parents, teachers, and students.

Responsibilities:

Student

- Teach all math content for special education students in grades 6 – 12 including but not limited to general math, pre-algebra, algebra and geometry
- Compile and review comprehensive evaluation data required to determine the appropriate eligibility of individual students
- Evaluate students' achievement based on collected data
- Develop specialized progress reports each semester, maintain a copy in the student's confidential folder, and disseminate a copy to families.

General

- Maintain compliance with federal, state, and local regulations and mandates
- Assure confidentiality of any personally identifiable information
- Develop IEPs and ensuring compliance using any or all of these items: MDT, and confidential files and reports
- Develop and coordinate all facets of an initial eligibility, including the development of all documentation for IEPs and initial student testing for students on the caseload.
- Communicate with families in general regarding special education concerns at EKA.
- Work with testing coordinator for testing accommodations as well as special education test proctoring.
