If you're 18 or over on Election Day, a U.S. citizen and registered, YES!! Make sure your registration is up to date and all your information is correct.

Deadline to register for this year's election: Oct. 13

Two Constitutional amendments:

Redistricting Changes process for redrawing political boundaries every 10 years.

"Yes" creates new redistricting commission of citizens and state legislators to draw districts.

"No" maintains state legislature control of redistricting.

Vehicle property tax relief for 100% disabled veterans

"Yes" One vehicle will be exempt from state personal property tax

"No" No tax relief

VOTE EARLY THIS YEAR - NO EXCUSE REQUIRED

Vote absentee by mail or drop box

- Request your absentee ballot before **Oct. 23**. To request online, you'll need your Virginia driver's license and social security number.
- Ballots are being mailed out. Vote your ballot; a witness is not required. Put it in the white envelope, SIGN IT, and put it in RETURN envelope. Seal the return envelope.
- Mail back or hand-deliver to your ballot drop off station. If mailed, ballot must be postmarked by **Nov. 3** and received by noon Nov. 6.
- Ballot drop off located at Registrars' offices and early voting locations. Two additional drop box locations for James City County voters are open 8 am-5 pm Monday-Saturday, beginning Oct. 19 through Oct. 31:

Vote early in person

Early voting in person begins **Sept. 18**. Voting locations open Monday-Friday and on the two Saturdays preceding the election (Oct. 24 and Oct. 31). Bring your ID (see below). Curbside voting/ballot drop box available.

New voter ID rules — photo ID no longer required

- Acceptable ID: VA driver's license, voter card, documents with your name and address, employee ID with photo or college student ID.
- Voters who do not have an acceptable ID may sign an ID confirmation statement.

Curbside voting/ballot dropoff available at all polls. Don't forget your ID!
