

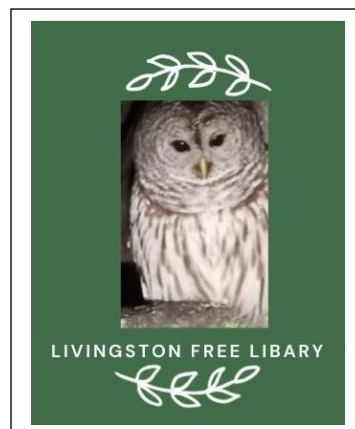


**MONDAY, APRIL 26<sup>TH</sup> AT 7PM**
