

# Changes at The Town of Livingston North Twin Lake Park .

- The park has become very popular and overcrowded.
- Livingston Residents have not been able to access the park during the summer months because of over crowding.
- The park is insured for 60 people and parking had to be limited to accommodate people driving, walking and bike riding.
- The people that live on this lake and near it have asked that the number of people using the lake be reduced.
- To maintain a safer environment the number of people in the water needed to be lowered.

Starting 6/15/21

- **The park is open at 10am and closes at 7pm June 15<sup>th</sup>- Labor Day.** Before June 15<sup>th</sup> and after Labor Day the park is open to the public dawn to dusk.
- To use the park between 6/15 and Labor Day you must have a pass issued by the Livingston town clerk.

Livingston Town Clerk office hours

**Sun-Mon -- closed Tues Weds Fri — 9-3 Thurs — 3-6 pm Sat — 9-12**

- All passes are free for Livingston residents and good for three years. You must show proof of residency with a driver's license, utility bill or rental lease.
- Livingston residents that have deeded access to the park must still get a pass and may use the park when they want. Parking however is not a deeded right.
- 25 passes were sold to early morning (dawn- 9am) swimmers and fisherman
- 25 passes were sold to non residents and can be used before 10 am after 7pm with limited parking in the small parking lot.
- **The large parking lot will be locked between 7pm and 10 am.** The small lot will remain unlocked for early morning swimming and fishing use.
- There is no parking on North Shore Drive, Ct.Rt 19 or any other near by roads to access the park.
- There are NO DOGS allowed in the park 6/15- Labor Day 10 am till 7pm
- There are NO FLOATS allowed in the water at any time. Kayaks, boats and paddle boards are permitted. PLEASE CLEAN YOUR BOAT PRIOR TO ENTERING THE LAKE.
