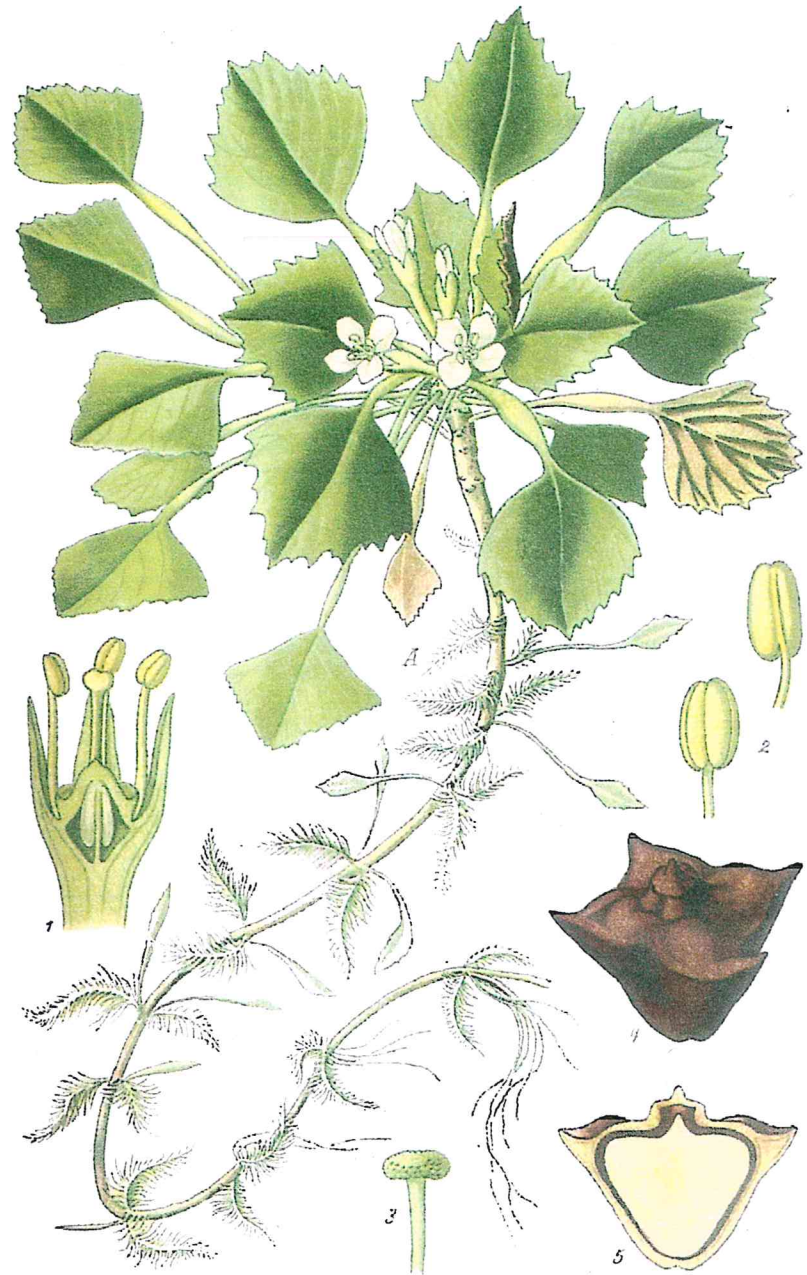


# Invasive Species Found In South Twin Lake: Water Chestnut Remove It seen

- **Carefully pull the plant and viable seeds from the water and dispose of them far from any waterbody.**
- **Each plant can spread through fruits and small fragments of itself.**
- **Viable seeds are green/brown, nonviable are black.**
- **Can severely impair boating and are extremely expensive to manage once extensively invaded.**
- **Any plant destroyed will prevent up to 120 new plants from growing next year!**
