

Annual East Coast DOG Cook-Off Rules and Schedule

Rules:

So, what are the rules? Not many.

- This is a 1-pot cook-off.
- Minors, under the age of 18, must have an adult present.
- The 1-Pot dish must be a main dish.
- Charcoal briquettes must be used, no propane.
- You may use an insert in your oven.
- Everyone must practice safe food handling techniques.
- Follow FDA recommended cooking temperatures for the item being cooked.
- Interaction with the public is encouraged. Please be courteous in sharing cooking information.
- We want this to be as fun for novices as the experienced, so judging will be based on a 90 – 10 points scale. Up to 90 points can be given for taste and edibility of the dish, and up to 10 points can be given for presentation of the dish.
- There will be a three person judging panel, and all judging decisions are final.
- You will have 2 ½ hours to cook.
- Prizes will be awarded for first, second and third places.
