



Range Safety Acknowledgment Form

Range Safety Rules:

1. ALWAYS TREAT ALL FIREARMS AS IF THEY ARE LOADED.
2. ALWAYS KEEP THE FIREARM'S MUZZLE POINTED DOWN RANGE/BERM.
3. ALWAYS KEEP YOUR FINGER OFF OF THE TRIGGER UNTIL READY TO SHOOT.
4. NEVER POINT YOUR FIREARM AT ANYTHING YOU ARE NOT WILLING TO DESTROY.

Boondock's Safety Rules:

- DO NOT LOAD OR HANDLE YOUR FIREARM UNTIL YOU ARE ON THE FIRING LINE AND ONLY WHEN TOLD TO DO SO BY AN INSTRUCTOR.
- DO NOT BACK AWAY FROM THE FIRING LINE UNTIL DIRECTED TO DO SO.
- DO NOT ATTEMPT TO CATCH OR PICK UP ANYTHING THAT YOU DROP WHILE ON THE FIRING LINE—WAIT UNTIL THE LINE IS CALLED "SAFE" TO "RECOVER YOUR GEAR" OR AN INSTRUCTOR HELPS YOU.
- IF YOU HAVE PROBLEMS OR NEED HELP WHILE ON THE FIRING LINE, KEEP YOUR FINGER OFF OF THE TRIGGER, KEEP YOUR FIREARM POINTED DOWNRANGE, AND RAISE YOUR NON-SHOOTING HAND—AN INSTRUCTOR WILL COME ASSIST YOU.
- NO CELL PHONE OR CAMERA USAGE ON THE RANGE; KEEP ELECTRONICS STORED IN YOUR BAG—NOT ON YOUR PERSON.

Required Safety Gear: **If you show up the day of your class without the required safety gear, you will need to purchase the required gear before heading to the range**

- EYE PROTECTION MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES.
- HEARING PROTECTION MUST BE WORN DURING ALL LIVE FIRE EXERCISES.
- A BRIMMED HAT OR VISOR IS REQUIRED WHILE ON THE RANGE.

If for any reason you are unable to complete the live fire exercise with the firearm you brought to the class, you will need to rent a firearm from our Pro Shop at a cost of \$25.00 per day, plus the cost of ammunition. If you choose to not rent a firearm and purchase the ammunition you will be responsible for any re-booking or cancellation fees, as stated in our Class Re-booking and Cancellation Policy. NOTE: DP1, DP2, Basic Carbine, and Tac Carbine require gear that rents for \$10/day.

GO HOME RULES

- No GUN HANDLING allowed in the classroom, pro shop, parking lot, or pavilion without an instructor directing you to do so.
- Any NEGLIGENT DISCHARGE where your bullet does not impact a safety berm.
- If you pull your gun OUT OF THE HOLSTER while you are not on the firing line.
- If you are on the firing line and you pull your gun OUT OF THE HOLSTER while an instructor or other student is down range.
- Your firearm DISCHARGES while you are attempting to RE-HOLSTER or your firearm discharges and the BULLET IMPACTS within 2 YARDS of yourself, an instructor or another student.
- You DROP a loaded firearm or a loaded firearm FALLS out of your holster.
- Repeated infractions of UNSAFE MUZZLING, TRIGGER FINGER issues, or UNSAFE RE-HOLSTERING.

GO HOME Infractions

A violation of any of the GO HOME RULES will result in a removal from the class without refund. You may re-take the class at a later date, but you will not be allowed to continue with Live Fire Exercises. If you came with another student, you can pack up your firearm and place it in your car, stay and watch or wait in the Pro-Shop or classroom
