

The Regional Vice-Presidents shall receive and transmit information to the Board and to all members through the Club's publication from members and member clubs within their respective region. The four Regional Vice-Presidents must reside in the region for which they hold office at the time they are elected. Regional Vice Presidents are required to be available for communication with all CCA members. Regional Vice Presidents are required to contact CCA Member Clubs within their regions each quarter to request the Member Club's quarterly report for the Chi Chatter prior to its deadline. Each Regional Vice president must be willing to be appointed First VP and be willing and able to serve as President of CCA should the need arise. From the four Regional Vice-Presidents, one Vice-President will be selected by vote of the Board to have the duties and exercise the powers of the President in case of the President's death, absence or incapacity. Vice Presidents are expected to seek the input of the membership in their area on issues being considered by the board, and to relay that information to the board during discussions.
