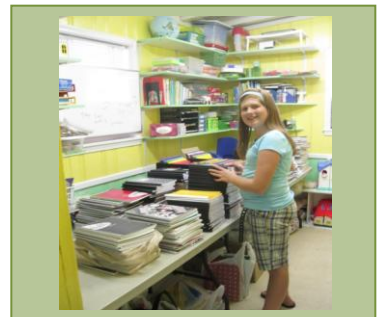


Dear Friends,

## *A Blessing to the Nations*

**Gwinnett County Fair-** Years ago upon returning from the mission field, I felt that a different approach needed to be taken to do evangelism in the United States. While the door-to-door campaigns are very effective in many countries, it is much more difficult to use that approach here in the states. One effective approach is to have a booth at the Gwinnett County Fair. This year completes our eighth year of doing evangelism. This year we were able to impact a very diversified market, from a young gang member, to a 78-year-old grandmother. We witnessed to people from all walks of life and cultures. Many were eager to receive Jesus. One young Vietnamese family could not speak English, but because of their computer skills they could read English. I cannot speak Vietnamese, but I was able to show them our tracks in English. I took them through question by question, phrase by phrase until they got to the very last question. "Would you like to open the door of your heart to receive Jesus?" They both tearfully accepted Jesus. We also led at least 10 people to the Lord from the country of Haiti, who are in the United States due to the devastating earthquake there. I am truly amazed at the number of people in the United States who want to understand who Jesus is and what He did for them. Because of the success at this year's fair, we started thinking about the possibilities of doing other local fairs, such as in the large fair in Marietta, Perry, and Columbus, GA and, the Georgia State Fair in Augusta. The opportunities will also include small local fairs like the one in Cummings, Dawson, and Habersham Counties. How exciting would it be to let people experience the mission field, and never leave their own country? Please dream with us, as we consider what 2012 could look like if we could implement these programs. Many souls are waiting for someone, anyone to give them the Good News. **Guatemala-**While ministering in the Indigenous area of Guatemala, I was humbled as I spoke in a village church of 25 people. The pastor had announced to the whole village our upcoming visit. I saw such potential ground for B2N to sow into, that I told the pastor that I would return in 2012. We must increase our evangelism classes, and continue taking trained teams to the streets to put their faith in action. On the most recent trip to Guatemala, we began developing our ministry strategy for 2012. We want our ninth year of ministry to be our most effective yet. We understand the Gospel is free, but it costs to get it into desolate areas. The world may be saying funds are in short supply, but our God is still saying Matt.9:37 "The harvest truly is plentiful, but the laborers are few.
