Educational activity programs, such as this field trip to visit Montreal as a spectator in a sporting event involve certain elements of risk. - Slip & fall, strains, sprains

I furthermore assume absolute responsibility and liability for such activities and, together with the Student, agree to indemnify and save harmless UCLCET, CHN, the school board in respect of which the Student is registered and all of their respective officers, directors, trustees, employees, representatives, agents, consultants and independent service providers (including but not limited to any transportation service provider(s)) from any and all liability for any and all actions, losses, damages and expenses (including, without limitation, the loss, damage or theft of money or property), personal injuries, or deaths, however caused.

Students will travel to this event by bus. Travel by bus involves certain elements of risk. The following list includes, but is not limited to, examples of the types of injuries which may occur while being transported to Montreal:

- Injuries related to a motor vehicle accident
