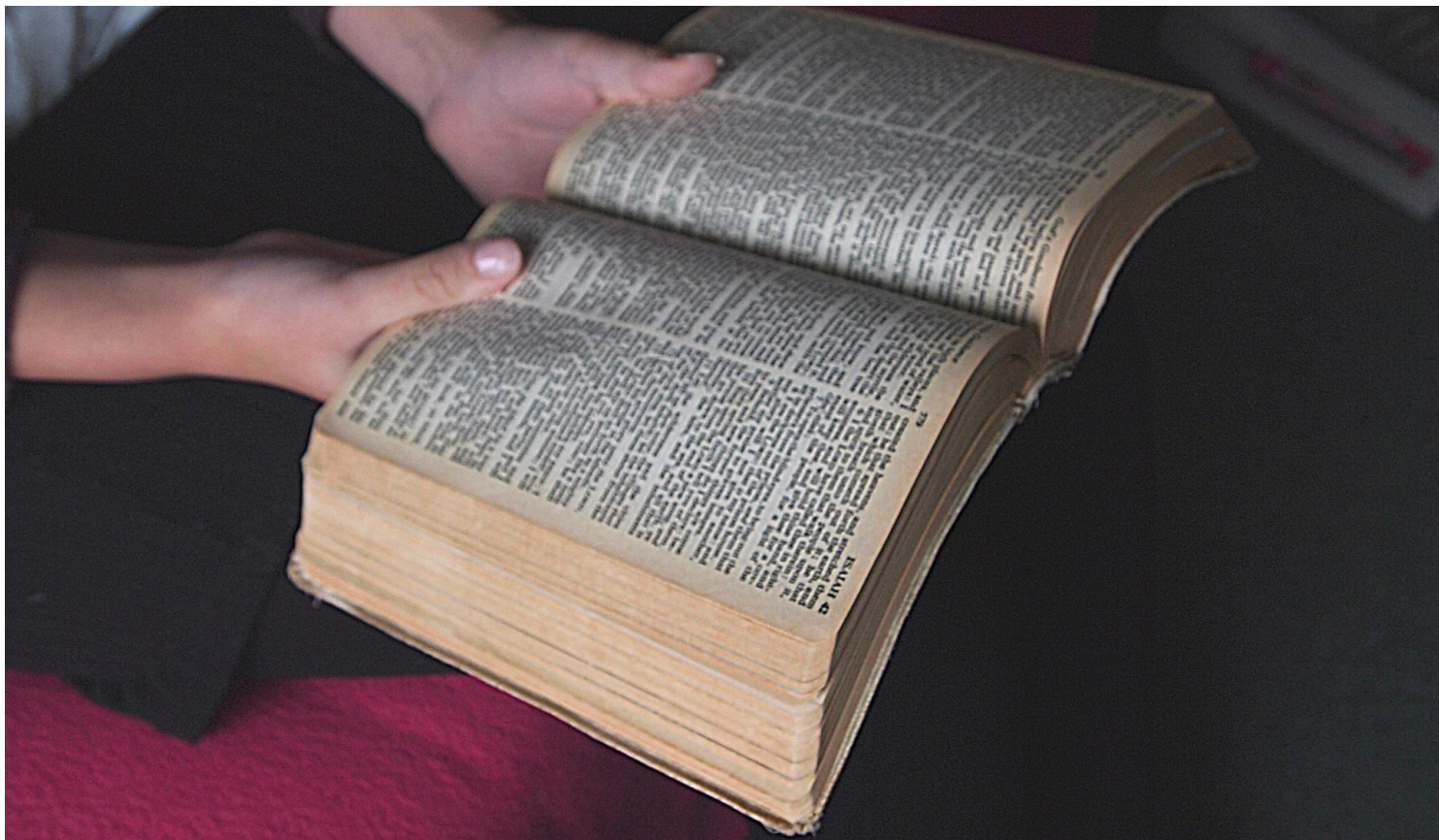




PSALM 27
