Part XXX:

“who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified; who has spoken through the prophets”

I have already touched on this first part of the last two lines. The Father, Son and Spirit are completely and entirely one with the exception of their relationships to one another. Therefore, giving glory and adoration to one person, gives glory and adoration to all. A good example of this idea comes from the movie the Shack. When Mack meets God, they all know what the other person heard even if it was in a different context or that person wasn't present for the conversation.

The Old Testament has two major concepts worth mentioning as we conclude this part on the Holy Spirit. Lady wisdom and the Spirit of God in the Old Testament are strongly connected with the nature of God. Although the Israelite people were strong monotheists and would not allow anything that remotely sounded like there are more than one god, they did allow language that personified God's wisdom and his power working through the prophets. For this reason, this line connected the mentality of the Old Testament to that of the New Testament where God speaks through his people through his Spirit working in and through them.
