1. Introduction – Open Public Hearing

The purpose of the proposed regulation is to provide clarity for the public, individuals and licensees through regulations. The proposed regulations makes changes to the procedures for application for and renewal of a certificate of registration as an environmental health specialist or environmental health specialist trainee; interprets the term “basic science courses”, requires notification to the Board of a name change, requires certain communications and documents to be address to the Board, establishes certain fees, defines the term “environmental health sciences”, revises requirements for continuing education and provides other matters properly relating thereto.
