Broadmoor School

Broadmoor School is the educational program for the Lake County Board of Developmental Disabilities/ Deepwood (LCBDD) and provides four programs for students from birth through age 22 years who have developmental disabilities and are residents of Lake County.

Early Intervention Program: For children from birth to 3 years who have been diagnosed with a disability and/or a developmental delay. Services are provided by teaming and coaching in everyday routines in a natural environment.

Integrated Preschool Program: For preschool-aged children ages 3 - 5 years with developmental disabilities, as well as preschoolers who are typically developing.

School Age Program: Instruction to meet the unique needs of students ages 6 - 22 years with developmental disabilities. Individual Education Plans (IEPs) are developed for optimal learning and development.

Lake Employment Experience Program (LEEP): A program that provides vocational training and school-to-work transition opportunities, as well as experiences in various integrated community settings for students ages 16 - 22 years.

Our goal is to develop academic skills to maximize each student's capacity, strengthen independence, increase life skills, develop competency, and enhance communication and social-emotional skills. Our programs include adaptive physical education, swimming, home economics, therapy services, art expression and technology training.

Located at 8090 Broadmoor Road in Mentor, Ohio, Broadmoor School follows a nine month school calendar (from late August through early June) and maintains school hours 9:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. The Early Intervention Program follows a twelve month calendar.

Children who have delays in speech/language, gross motor and/or fine motor, cognitive, and/or social adaptive behaviors may be eligible to receive services from our Broadmoor School. If you have questions about your child's development, our staff can help direct you to the individuals or programs which may best meet your needs.
