

WHAT YOU CAN DO TO ENSURE YOUR RESULTS ARE CORRECT

1. Ensure that your race number is correct and that your information (name, age, gender, event, division) matches what you want.
2. Ensure that the race number is pinned to your front between your waist and chest.
3. Ensure that the race number is horizontally oriented so a person in front of you can read it from left to right.
4. Ensure that the entire race number is clearly visible while you cross the finish line or any other timing area. Do not block any part of the race number during this time.
5. Ensure that your posted results are correct once you finish the event. Normally results are posted within a minute of when a person finishes.

Let the race organizer or timer know as soon as possible if you see any errors. It is best to do this before the awards ceremony takes place.
