

*How do South Carolinians view the issue of nurses and their supervision?*

- 78.4% of South Carolinians surveyed want the current practice of requiring medical doctor supervision for administration of anesthesia to continue.
- 71.5% of South Carolinians surveyed say better access to care by allowing nurse anesthetists to work without physician supervision is not worth the potential increase in risk to patients.
