



OculusDocs COVID-19 Policy

OculusDocs in Vernon and Middletown are open for routine eye exams and urgent care. We are fully committed to the health and safety of our patients and staff and are following both CDC and Connecticut guidelines. As a Health Care facility, we require every patient to wear a mask covering the nose and mouth upon entering and for the duration of your visit. We ask that you please come by yourself, unless you require translation or mobility assistance or are under the age of 18 and must be accompanied by one adult.

If you are sick or have any symptoms that are related to COVID-19, we ask you to please stay home and contact your primary care doctor. In case you may have been exposed to COVID-19, but have not experienced any symptoms, we also ask you to please stay at home to follow quarantine protocols and reschedule your appointment at least 2 weeks later from your original appointment. This is not only for our protection, but for **your own and others around you**, therefore we ask that you please comply.

HAVE AN APPOINTMENT? WHAT TO EXPECT:

- 1) Please wear a **mask and bring your own pen, photo ID and insurance card.**
- 2) While you are reviewing and signing your paperwork, a staff member will scan your cards and sanitize them before handing them back to you and then we will collect your paperwork.
- 3) A technician will then direct you inside for your preassessment to review your medical history before you see the doctor. We have installed plexi glass barriers for protection.
- 4) **MASKS ARE REQUIRED THE DURATION OF YOUR VISIT!! Thank you!**

WE WANT TO KEEP YOU SAFE:

Our office hopes that you as well as loved ones are staying as safe as possible. We have taken extra precautions to keep staff and patients safe during this time.

Popular Quick FAQ's:

Will my eyeglasses carry COVID-19 germs or protect me from germs like a face mask?

- Disinfect your eyeglasses frequently, they are not proven to protect your eyes 100%, but do help in the incident someone coughs or sneezes around you.

Are wearing my contacts safe or sanitary during my visit?

- Yes, however proper hand washing is necessary and disinfecting your contacts lenses regularly is a must. Stop wearing your contacts lenses if you are sick.
